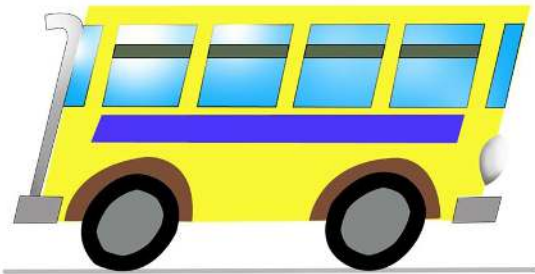

Tips for Parents:

- Get to know your child's teacher and other support staff at the start of the year. Let them know about any special needs your child might have so they can cater for their needs optimally.
