Adapting to Online Lessons

With the number of lockdowns that we have had over the last eighteen months, it has become the norm for tutoring sessions to transition to Zoom during these periods. Most of you have embraced and adapted to online learning despite the challenges that it initially presented. Some students are even doing lessons entirely via the Zoom platform on a weekly basis.

The following are some of the things that make online lessons, and any lesson for that matter, more productive and engaging for the student.

- **Communication:** You and your child are encouraged to inform me of the topics that you will be covering so that I plan your lessons ahead of time. I normally gather quizzes, open ended activities and interactive tasks to complete during the lessons. If I know what topic or topics you are learning, I will have those activities ready for your lesson.
- **Remediation:** If there are areas which you have found challenging and have not done well in in the past, please let me know. While covering current work, I will revisit past topics to build confidence and make sure that those areas are understood well.
