

General Maths 3 and 4 – What's new?

- The new General Mathematics 3 and 4 is essentially the old Further Mathematics 3 and 4 with a few changes. In unit 3, students will still study data and financial mathematics as before. In Unit 4 however, the two areas of study, Matrices and Networks and Decision Mathematics are compulsory areas of study instead of two options as was the case in the previous syllabus.
- In terms of assessment, the in-school assessment contributes to 40% of the score with Data and Financial Mathematics contributing 24% and unit 4 contributing 16% of the marks. The external assessment consists of two 90 minutes exams each contributing 30% of the score. If you are studying General Mathematics 3 and 4, you are highly advised to have a hard copy of the syllabus and tick relevant sections off as you progress through the course.
